When Samir Ali, a little boy from the slum areas, joined the HOPE *foundation* school, he was unruly, disobedient, and irregular. He would use slang regularly and often disturbed the whole class with his antics. However, the teachers were extremely patient with him and gave him love and attention. He is now an obedient well-behaved child. He comes to school regularly and also completes his homework. His family was so impressed with the changes in his son that his father came to the school himself to talk to his teacher. He shared that his son, who never wanted to go to school but run around and play with his friends, now gets up early to get ready to go to school. HOPE *foundation* and ITC give their whole family a chance for a better life by transforming and educating Samir.
