Though N. Pradeep Kumar's parents are farmers, they gave their best to give him and his sister a good education. He came to Hyderabad for his college education. Though he completed his degree, every job interview he went for required knowledge of computers. He was struggling to find a job. He heard about the Dell Computer Centre from one of his friends and enrolled in January. Though he was very eager to attend the classes and learn, he started missing his classes. When the staff followed up on him, they learnt that he could not afford to pay the fees and that he did not have the money to travel to the centre. Encouraged by the staff, he came back to the centre in March. He was so eager to learn that he came to the centre by walking long distances on foot. Soon after he completed the course, he got through an interview with Accenture and they offered him a salary of INR 14000 (USD 325) a month which was more than he expected. He is very grateful to HOPE foundation for helping him realise his dreams of supporting his family and encouraging not to give up hope.
